Description of Volunteer Opportunity

The NE Basecamp Board of Directors comprises leaders from the nonprofit and for-profit sector who are dedicated to the organization's mission. Serving on the NE Basecamp Board of Directors is an opportunity for individuals who are passionate about strengthening professional development for educators. Board terms are three years and board members may serve up to two consecutive terms.

Board members are expected to:

- attend quarterly board meetings, reading materials related to the agenda in advance of meetings and to come prepared to ask questions and participate in discussions.
- serve on one or more committees of the board and to actively participate in committee work.
- support the Executive Director in securing the financial resources necessary for NE Basecamp to achieve its mission. Board members are expected to help the board fulfill its fiduciary responsibilities.
- responsibly represent NE Basecamp to their respective communities and to advocate for NE Basecamp's mission, programs, and services as appropriate.
